WAY OF LIFE

CADDO TRIBES WORE MOCCASINS , BECAUSE IT REPRESENTED THAT THEY GREW COTTON ON THEIR LAND.

FOOD

The Caddo's food that they grew and ate was maize, jerky, beans, squash, deer, rabbits, and turkey.





CLOTHING

The Caddos wore moccasins, dresses, pants, and wove cloth.

HOUSING



For housing, the Caddos used mud, trees, and reeds (or tall grasses) to build beehive like houses.

WEAPONS



For weapons, the Caddos used Bow and arrows and spears.

TOOLS



For tools the Caddos used stone axes, bones and stone.



CRAFTS

For crafts the caddos made pots, cups and pottery.

JEWELRY



For jewelry, they used shells, bone and stone.

POTTERY

For pottery they used mud, clay, and water.
